Taking a different approach to the traditional French twist, Tammy created volume at the crown of Brandy's head and, picking up sections of hair as she went, twisted the hair down to the nape of Brandy's neck. The loose ends fall softly across her shoulder. "Some brides still like to have some hair down, but don't want it falling down," Tammy says. When styling fine hair, Tammy recommends not washing the hair the day before as this helps it hold the style. Also, conditioning only the ends will keep the roots lighter to help create volume.
